APPLICATION FOR THE PARENT INFORMATION NETWORK (PIN) SHERRY SHEPHERD SARGENT SCHOLARSHIP 2019-2020 School Year

Purpose: To provide an academic scholarship to a deserving Cherry Creek School District High School Senior student to further his/her academic aspirations.

Award Components: One (1) \$2,000.

Criteria:

- 1. Applicant must: (1) Be a senior high school student attending one of the Cherry Creek School District high schools, (2) Be expected to graduate following the spring semester in the year of the awarded scholarship, and (3) Have either been accepted to or applied to an accredited university or college. (The scholarship will only be awarded to a student accepted by and attending an accredited university or college.)
- 2. In an effort to make higher education opportunities available to as many students as possible, this scholarship will not be awarded to a student who has been offered or accepted a full ride scholarship to attend a public, private, or service institution.
- 3. Applicant must demonstrate a commitment to education through a minimum grade point average of 3.0 out of a 4.0. (unweighted). In selecting the recipient of this scholarship, the student's academic, community service, and financial need will be considered by the committee.
- 4. Upon acceptance, the applicant must provide the following information: name of the accepting college/university, student ID #, to whom the check should be made out, an address where the check should be sent, phone number and email address. The scholarship recipient must also inform Dr. Sargent about the results of each college freshman grading period and how he/she is doing in general.
- 5. The recipient should also arrange with Dr. Sargent a visit to a PIN meeting during the first 6-8 months of the freshman year to inform the members of his/her college experiences and what the scholarship has meant.
- 6. The application must be emailed to PINSSSCCSD@gmail.com by Sunday, March 1st.
- 7. Finalists will be notified by Friday, March 20th. Finalists must be available for interviews which will be held Wednesday April 8th between 2:30 and 6:00pm. One recipient and one alternate will be selected. All finalists will be notified of their status by Friday, April 10th.
- 8. This scholarship will be awarded at the Annual PIN Brunch on the morning of Tuesday, April 28th, and, if at all possible, the scholarship recipient should be in attendance.

- 1. Completed typed application form (handwritten and/or incomplete applications <u>will not</u> be processed). Application forms are available at https://www.ccsdfoundation.org/ccsf-grants#scholarships.
- 2. One (1) letter of recommendation from high school teacher, counselor, administrator/principal.
- 3. A complete high school transcript.
- 4. Your counselor may be notified of your application.
